## God Raises Up a New Generation of Leaders in Belize

God answered prayer in so many ways for Good News Across Belize. We asked God for a team of 30 people and He gave us 35. We prayed for an outreach to 5,000 children and God gave us 10,000. We planned to give out 100 sets of Bible lesson material but interest in the material and training was so much more than expected, we needed 100 more.

The focus of this outreach was to train nationals to begin a *Good News Club*® ministry in schools, churches and homes. Besides ourselves, Janet and I hand-selected 6 trainers to conduct training. The trainers arrived in Belize City

early in order to conduct weekend training seminars for church leaders and Belizean believers who had stepped up and were ready and excited about Good News Clubs. There were 258 teachers trained that weekend in 4 locations.

After the weekend training I was part of the Sugar City team. We held Good News Clubs for 5 days in schools, churches, and day cares. These were 'demonstration' *Good News Clubs* so those who had attended the training on the weekend could see a club in action. Doors were wide open to the schools and we were welcomed by teachers and principals. When we asked how much time we could have to share with children often the answer was, "As much time as you would like." God was at work through your prayers and as a result 470 children were counselled for salvation! Thank you for praying! A team of trainers stayed back in Belize after the blitz to conduct more training and already 114 Good News Clubs have started. I am so thankful for all the ways God worked and to have been involved.

## God Raises up New Teachers in Anguilla

April 8th was graduation day for this fine looking group of trained teachers. This is a combination of graduates of *Teaching Children Effectively™* Level 1 and *Little Kids Can Know God* courses held in Anguilla over the past few months.

It was a blessing to be able to travel to Anguilla April 14-24, to conduct the *Little Kids Can Know God* course. The travel arrangements to Anguilla were quite a challenge as much of this area was greatly affected by hurricane Irma. The damage was still obvious and flying to Puerto Rico,

St. Martin and then Anguilla was difficult and costly. However, God made the way. Our last leg of the journey from St. Martin to Anguilla is normally done by ferry, but the ferry was damaged so we had to take a motor boat to get there. Even as the people dealt with terrible property damage it has not daunted their spirit and fortitude. The students were excited to learn how to teach Little Kids. The highlight for me was to observe the students as they did their teaching practicum in a preschool classroom using the tools and knowledge they have gained in the course. During her practicum one teacher was struggling to give an invitation to receive Christ to the children. Her teaching partner assisted her and also counselled the children. Later the teacher admitted to her teaching partner that she did not believe she had received Christ. Right there on the steps of the preschool she received Christ as her Savior.
